Gujarat education department announces common academic calendar for UG & PG courses

begin from June 21. Diwali holiday will begin from November 10 and the vacation for all universities including GTU will be the same duration. Universities will conduct first internal evaluations from December 1-16. Second academic session, UG semester 2, 4, 6 and PG semester 2, 4, will begin from December 2023 and end on April 30, 2024. The second internal evaluations will be conducted from April 1-30. The second academic session will end by April 30 and 46 days of summer vacation will begin from May 1. The new academic year will begin from June 17, 2024.

Sources said that the academic calendar does not mention the schedule for final exams which is confusing. The statement asks teaching and non-teaching staff to be prepared for duty during internal evaluations.

GANDHINAGAR: The Gujarat government on Friday restructured the format for recruitment of Class III employees which include head clerks, senior clerks and junior clerks in government service. Announcing the Gujarat Subordinate Services, Class III (Group A and Group B) (Combined Competitive Examination) Rules 2023, the state government said that the examination will be held in two phases - the first being a primary qualifying exam and the second being the main examination. Under the new format, the vacancies of clerks in the government will be bifurcated into two parts. Group A will include head clerks, senior clerks, office assistants in the sachivalaya, and junior clerks in collectorates. Group B will have junior clerks in all government departments except collectorates.

ACB probes assets of 16 govt employees

Rajkot: The noose is tightening around 16 government employees, who are among the 47 people arrested in the dummy candidates racket busted by Bhavnagar police with the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) launching a detailed probe into their assets.

In the last 10 days, the Bhavnagar ACB has been gathering details of their properties, Aadhar, and PAN cards from the family members of the accused. The questioning of the 16 government employees on Wednesday and they voluntarily declared the details of their properties.

Govt restructures format for recruitment of clerks



Aspirants will be required to fill in only one application form either for vacancy in Group A or Group B or both. In an attempt to ensure that maximum number of applicants appear for the examination, the government said candidates who take the exam will be returned their application fee. The preliminary examination will be of 100 marks and will last for one hour. Separate merit lists will be prepared for Group A and Group B. The main examination for Group A will carry 350 marks while the main examination for Group B will carry 200 marks.

A statement of the Gujarat Subordinate Service Selection Board (GSSSB), which conducts the examinations for clerk level positions in the government, said that aspirants can choose the place where they wish to appear for the examination.

Teen girl trying to protect mother stabbed 17 times

SURAT: City police arrested a 45-year-old migrant worker on Friday for allegedly killing his 19-year-old daughter and attacking his wife and sons.



The accused stabbed his daughter 17 times as she tried to protect her mother in the grisly attack.

Accused Ramanuj Sahoo then attacked his wife, Rekha (40), stabbing her 10 times besides chopping off two fingers. The police arrested Sahoo near his home in Kadodara GIDC area for the murder and attack on his wife.

Sahoo, a textile mill worker, killed his daughter Chanda and injuring his wife. In the attack, their three sons Suraj (16), Dhiraj (14) and Vishal (12) too suffered injuries while trying to save their mother.

The deceased came to save her mother. However, the accused is yet to reveal the reasons behind his stabbing the girl so many times. She

died on the spot sustaining injuries on vital organs," said a police officer.

After the girl collapsed on the floor, the woman ran towards the terrace to save her life with her husband chasing her and stabbing her there too.

"The mother suffered at least 10 stabbing injuries and two of her fingers were chopped off."

She has been operated upon to attach the fingers and is still admitted in the hospital," said the police.

Cops are questioning the accused to find out exactly what conspired between them prior to developing the dispute over going to sleep on the terrace.

As the accused is still not revealing details, the police may seek custody for further investigation.

Can't sue hospital after free treatment: Consumer panel

AHMEDABAD: The Gujarat State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission has said that a government hospital like the Civil Hospital in Ahmedabad that provides free of charge treatment to patients cannot be sued for deficiency in service. The commission refused to entertain a complaint against the Civil Hospital and its doctors for deficiency in service when they appeared to have forgotten an instrument like scissors' inside a patient's stomach after a surgery. The commission said that it has no competent jurisdiction for adjudication of the complaint. In this case, one Kamabhai Chavda from

Rapar taluka in Kutch had brought his wife Jivben for treatment in 2012. She was advised for a surgery known as splenectomy. She did not get any respite even after the surgery and her pain persisted. As it aggravated after some time, investigation revealed that there was a foreign material like scissors in her stomach. She underwent another surgery in April 2017, but she did not recover and died in September 2017.

Chavda alleged negligence on part of the doctors involved in her first surgery and deficiency in service on part of the hospital and claimed Rs 85 lakh in compensation.

As the treatment was free of charge, the commission said, "Even the payment of token charge will not be treated as 'consideration' to fall it within the scope of service. The record shows that the patient was given treatment at Civil Hospital, Ahmedabad, and it is free service because no record shows that complainant has paid any fees. Thus, when the 'treatment' rendered to patient is not 'service', the complainant is not a 'consumer'."

With this observation, the commission rejected the complaint.

XBB.1.16 variant dominant in Gujarat

AHMEDABAD: The analysis of Covid variants in Gujarat by the Gujarat Biotechnology Research Centre (GBRC) indicated that in the past, of the 100 genomic sequences, 80 or 80% were found to be XBB.1.16 or XBB.1.16.1, a sub-variant of Omicron. Out of the 100 past sequences, 54 were from Ahmedabad, 27 from Vadodra, and six each from Mehsana and Gandhinagar. On Friday, GBRC recorded 11 new Covid cases.

SoBo accountant sexorted out of Rs 4 lakh by Insta friend

AHMEDABAD: A 22-year-old woman from South Bopal, who works as an accountant with a private firm, on Thursday filed a complaint with the Bopal police alleging that a man from Isanpur, who was her friend on Instagram, extorted Rs 1 lakh and gold worth Rs 3 lakh from her while threatening to make her nude pictures viral.

The woman said in her FIR that a man named Jay Nagar, sent her a request to follow her on April 5 which she accepted. She accepted the request on April 7 and they began chatting.

On the first week of May, Nagar convinced her to send nude pictures of her to him which she did. On May 12, Nagar sent her a message demanding Rs 1 lakh from her. "He threatened me that if I will not give him money then he would make her nude pictures viral on social media. Scared, I sent him money through UPI on May 13," she said in the complainant.

On May 14, he again sent her a message seeking gold threatening her of making her pictures viral. The woman then stole jewellery worth Rs 3 lakh from her house and handed over the jewellery to Nagar at her office in Bopal. On May 17, when her mother checked the cupboard in their house, she did not find the jewellery and decided to approach police. At that time, the girl told her mother that she had taken the jewellery and gave them to her Instagram friend. She narrated the entire story to file a police complaint.

The police have registered a complaint of extortion, breach of trust, cheating, defamation and criminal intimidation under IPC along with the charges of the Information Technology act.
