Row erupts over 'dean missing' posters at MSU

staff on Friday when the student leaders pasted posters of 'Dean missing' at the main building of the Faculty of Commerce. The student leaders of the National Students Union of India (NSUI) were demanding that the faculty should declare a date on which students seeking admission in first year Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) can come for document verification.

"We were forced to put up such posters," he said. "Whenever we come for genuine representation, the faculty dean is not available," said NSUI Vadodara's president Amar Waghela. "There are several

students whose document verification is pending. All we are demanding is that the faculty should declare a date on which such students, whose document verification is pending, can come for the same so that their academic year does not get spoiled," he said.

"But, like in the past, even on Friday, when we reached the faculty to make a representation, the dean was not available. Hence, we were forced to put up such posters," he said.

The student leaders alleged that students whose document verification is pending were forced to move from pillar to post. "Whenever they approach the university head office, they are asked to contact the faculty dean. But the faculty dean does not hear to any representation," he said.

As soon as the student leaders put up the posters with photo of the dean, the vigilance staff pulled the posters and tore them after which the students' group and the staff members entered into heated arguments.

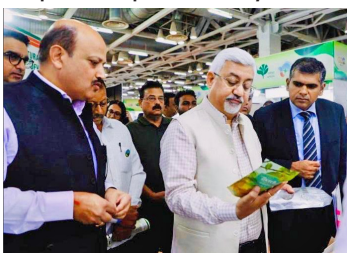
Dr. Radhakrishnan Award 2023

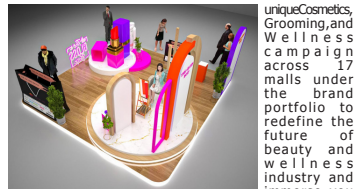
